2020 PLAYERS OF THE YEAR



GRAHAM MOODY

GRAHAM IS NOW A TWO-TIME CONSECUTIVE OJG PLAYER OF THE YEAR. AT THE AGE OF 17, HE HAS A +3.3 HANDICAP AND IS THE 90TH BOB NORQUIST OREGON JUNIOR AMATEUR CHAMPION. HE ALSO PLACED 2ND IN THE 68TH OREGON MEN'S STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP AT SALISHAN GOLF LINKS WITH (+1) 68-70-73=211. IN THE 4 OJG MAJORS TOURNAMENTS GRAHAM COMPETED IN THIS YEAR, HE FINISHED TOP 5 AND POSTED TWO 1-UNDER FINISHES. GOING INTO HIS SENIOR YEAR, GRAHAM HAS ALREADY COMMITTED TO PLAYING COLLEGIATE GOLF AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-MADISON, HOME OF THE BADGERS.

KYRA LY

KYRA IS NOW A TWO-TIME CONSECUTIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR FOR OREGON JUNIOR GOLF AND HAS 5 TOURNAMENT ROUNDS UNDER PAR POSTED THIS YEAR. AT THE AGE OF 15, SHE HOLDS A +4.2 HANDICAP AND HAS WON TWO 2020 MAJORS: THE 90TH BOB NORQUIST OREGON JUNIOR AMATEUR AND THE CENTRAL WILLAMETTE JUNIOR. SHE ALSO PLACED 1ST IN TWO SUMMER SERIES EVENTS: GLENDOVEER JUNIOR WITH 7-UNDER (65), AND HERON LAKES WITH 5-UNDER (67). IN JUNE, KYRA COMPETED IN THE 111TH OREGON AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP, AND MADE IT TO THE ROUND OF 16.

2020 MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

THIS YEAR OREGON JUNIOR GOLF SAW A SIGNIFICANT INCREASE IN MEMBERSHIP. OJG CLOSED MEMBERSHIP ON OCTOBER 15TH TO PREPARE FOR GHIN 'S GUARDIAN MANAGEMENT UPDATE AND HAD A TOTAL OF 2782 MEMBERS COMPARED TO LAST YEARS TOTAL OF 1980. AN OJG ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP COSTS \$30 AND IS AVAILABLE TO RESIDENTS IN OREGON AND SW WASHINGTON WHO ARE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 8 AND 18.



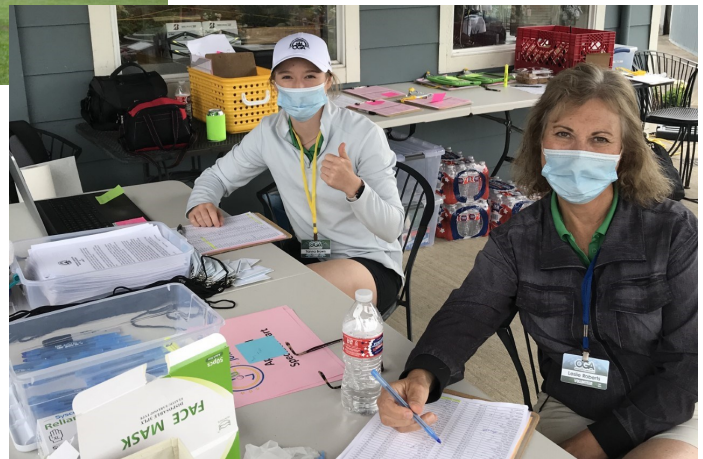

GOLFING DURING A PANDEMIC

THIS YEAR WE ALL WERE FACED WITH NEW CHALLENGES AND EXCITING OPPORTUNITIES DUE TO COVID-19. EVEN THOUGH COVID BROUGHT SOCIAL DISTANCING INTO OUR LIVES, IT ALSO MANAGED TO BRING MORE PEOPLE TOGETHER WITH THE GAME OF GOLF. GOLF IS ONE OF THE FEW SPORTS WHERE PLAYERS CAN ENJOY GOLFING WITH THEIR FRIENDS WHILE STILL BEING ABLE TO SOCIAL DISTANCE. THROUGHOUT THIS YEAR, WE HAD A POSITIVE INCREASE IN JUNIORS COMPETING IN OJG TOURNAMENTS, PLAYERS USING THEIR BENEFITS OF THE YOC PROGRAM, AND GOLFERS WHO ARE NEW TO THE GAME AND ARE EXCITED TO LEARN HOW TO GOLF.

PLAYERS HAD TO ADAPT TO NO RAKES IN BUNKERS, HAVING POOL NOODLES IN THE HOLE, AND NOT BEING ABLE TO REMOVE THE FLAGSTICK. SPECTATORS WERE LIMITED TO A 1 SPECTATOR PER PLAYER POLICY AND WERE REQUIRED TO WEAR A BADGE WHILE STAYING 6FT APART. THE STAFF WAS IN CHARGE OF IMPLEMENTING SOCIAL DISTANCING WITH NEW PROCEDURES AT STARTING AND SCORING, HAVING SANITIZER ACCESSIBLE AT ALL TABLES, AND ENSURING EVERYONE PARTICIPATING HAD SIGNED A WAIVER.

LUCAS HUGHES SHOT 71, 69, 72 TO FINISH (-4) FOR THE 3-DAY TOURNAMENT. HE HAD 11 BIRDIES OVER THE THREE ROUNDS AND HOLED OUT FOR AN IMPRESSIVE EAGLE ON HOLE 10 IN ROUND 1 TO SHOOT 33 ON THE BACK 9. HE LED THE FIELD ALL THREE DAYS AND FINISHED 3 STROKES AHEAD OF ELI HUNTINGTON WHO TOOK SECOND WITH (-1) .



ELLI GORDON SHOT 77, 76, 72 FOR A TOTAL SCORE OF 225 (+9) . SHE HAD 5 BIRDIES OVER THE 3 ROUNDS AND TOOK FIRST BY 4 STROKES. THIS LEFT SOFIA FUENMAYOR TO COMPETE AGAINST JACINDA LEE IN A SCORECARD PLAYOFF FOR THE RUNNER-UP TROPHY. IN THE SECOND ROUND, GORDON CARDED A BIRDIE ON THE 9TH HOLE, A DIFFICULT 318 YD, PAR 4, FEATURING A CREEK THAT ALL PLAYERS MUST CARRY ON THEIR APPROACH TO AN ELEVATED GREEN WHICH IS ALSO BLOCKED WITH 2 FRONT BUNKERS.

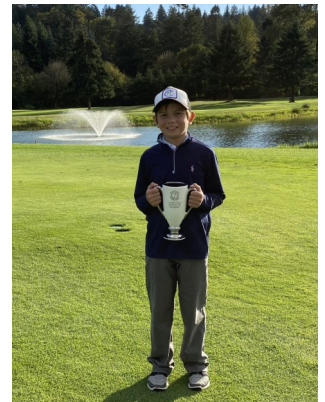

THANK YOU CREEKSIDE GOLF CLUB FOR HOSTING CHARLOTTE ' S TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS ON SEPTEMBER 26TH. IT WAS AN UNFORGETTABLE TOURNAMENT TO BRING THE SUMMER SERIES SEASON TO AN END. WE HAD 4 CHAMPIONS POST UNDER PAR SCORES: CHRIS CAYFORD (-1) , JAKE A. RODGERS (-5) , DREW WOOLWORTH (-5) , AND NATALIE YEN (-1) . WE ALSO HAD AN OUTSTANDING HOLE IN ONE BY DREW WOOLWORTH ON THE 6TH HOLE, A 127 YD. PAR 3, AND WAS HIS 4TH AGE TO CELEBRATE THIS YEAR.

YOUTH ON COURSE

ONE OF THE BENEFITS OF BEING AN OREGON JUNIOR GOLF MEMBER IS THE AUTOMATIC ENROLLMENT INTO THE YOUTH ON COURSE PROGRAM. THIS NATIONWIDE PROGRAM IS CONTINUALLY GROWING THE GAME OF GOLF WITH OUR YOUTH.

THE CORE PURPOSE OF YOUTH ON COURSE IS TO PROVIDE YOUTH ACCESS TO LIFE-CHANGING OPPORTUNITIES THROUGH GOLF AND ELIMINATE THE COSTS AS A BARRIER OF ENTRY INTO THE GAME. THE ORGANIZATION ACHIEVES THIS BY SUBSIDIZING ROUNDS SO YOUTH CAN PLAY FOR \$5 OR LESS AT OVER 1,200 COURSES NATIONWIDE.

IN THE LAST 3 YEARS, OREGON JUNIOR GOLF HAS PAID SUBSIDIES TOTALING NEARLY \$150,000 TO FACILITATE YOC. THIS YEAR ALONE, OJG WILL PAY OVER \$100,000 IN SUBSIDIES TO PARTICIPATING FACILITIES, TOTALING OVER 20,000 ROUNDS OF GOLF THAT JUNIORS HAVE PLAYED THROUGHOUT THIS YEAR IN OREGON AND SW WASHINGTON.

- NO ADVANCED TEE TIME—MUST CALL ON DAY OF DESIRED PLAY
- TEE TIMES AVAILABLE AFTER 2PM MONDAY— FRIDAY ONLY (NO WEEKENDS & HOLIDAYS)
- NO POWER CART RENTAL FOR JUNIORS (UNLESS PLAYING WITH PARENT OR GUARDIAN)
- JUNIORS WHO DO NOT FOLLOW THE POLICIES WILL BE CHARGED FACILITIES NORMAL JUNIOR RATE



YOUTH ON COURSE 100 HOLE HIKE

TOGETHER THE HIKERS RAISED OVER \$19,000 FOR OREGON JUNIOR GOLF. CODY PITZ LEAD THE TEAM IN FUNDRAISING WITH \$10,036. THE CHILDREN'S COURSE HOSTED THE EVENT AND HAD THE COURSE IN AMAZING CONDITION. PARTICIPANTS STARTED AT 7:30AM, AND EVERYONE WAS DONE BY 2:30PM. CODY WAS FIRST TO FINISH AFTER HE RAN OVER 36 HOLES AND EVEN COMPLETED AN EXTRA 6 HOLES. THE MONEY RAISED WILL GO TOWARD THE YOC SUBSIDIES OREGON JUNIOR GOLF WILL BE PAYING OUT THIS YEAR.

YVONNE VINCERI QUALIFIES FOR THE LPGA PORTLAND CLASSIC

OREGON JUNIOR GOLFER YVONNE VINCERI WON THE PDX AMATEUR OPEN ON AUGUST 13 AT LANGDON FARMS GOLF CLUB. AS THE CHAMPION, SHE QUALIFIED TO PLAY WITH THE PROFESSIONALS IN THE PORTLAND CLASSIC PRESENTED BY CAMBIA. DURING QUALIFYING, YVONNE PLAYED WITH FELLOW OJG MEMBER EMILY SONG AND HAD AN INCREDIBLE ROUND. SHE SCORED A 33 (-2) ON THE FRONT 9, AND ENDED WITH A THRILLING EAGLE ON HOLE 18 TO SHOOT A PERSONAL BEST OF 68 (-4) . YVONNE TEED IT UP ON SEPTEMBER 17TH TO COMPETE IN THE LPGA PORTLAND CLASSIC BEFORE STARTING HER SENIOR YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL. IN HER DEBUT ROUND AT COLUMBIA EDGEWATER CC, SHE FINISHED WITH A SCORE OF 84. EVEN THOUGH SHE UNFORTUNATELY MISSED THE CUT, IN THE 2ND ROUND SHE HAD A GREAT COMEBACK WITH 3 BIRDIES TO POST A SOLID SCORE OF 74.



FORMER OJG MEMBER'S COLLEGIATE SPOTLIGHT

EARNED 2020 BIG SKY FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR AT WEBER STATE UNIVERSITY. IN HIS COLLEGIATE DEBUT AT THE GENE MIRANDA FALCON INVITATIONAL, HE SHOT 1-UNDER 71 IN THE OPENING ROUND. HE FINISHED HIS FRESHMAN YEAR WITH A SCORING AVERAGE OF 73.40 AND RECORDED A 68 FOR HIS LOWEST 18 HOLE SCORE. IN HIS LAST TOURNAMENT AS A FRESHMAN, HE FINISHED 2-UNDER AND TIED FOR 3RD WITH A TOTAL SCORE OF 214 (69-74-71) .

FINISHED HIS FRESHMAN YEAR AT THE UNIVERSITY OF OREGON WITH A SCORING AVERAGE OF 72.55, PLACING HIM 2ND ON THE TEAM. HE ALSO HAD 67 BIRDIES AND 3 ROUNDS IN THE 60S WHICH TIED HIM FOR A TEAM BEST. ON PAR 4S, HE LED THE TEAM WITH A 4.14 SCORING AVERAGE. IN HIS FIRST COLLEGIATE EVENT, HE TIED FOR 9TH WITH A 2-UNDER AT THE NIKE COLLEGIATE INVITATIONAL WITH A SCORE OF 142(72-70) .

RACHEL DRGASTIN

GRADUATED IN 2020 FROM GEORGE FOX UNIVERSITY. RACHEL WAS NAMED NWC FRESHMAN PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN 2016 AFTER WINNING THE NORTHWEST CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT WITH A 78-71=149. IN HER SENIOR YEAR, SHE RECORDED A 77.21 SCORING AVERAGE AND WAS RANKED 19TH IN NCAA WOMEN: DIVISION 3 PLAYERS. SHE ALSO MADE 3 CONSECUTIVE D3 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP APPEARANCES WITH THE TEAM, AND DURING HER JUNIOR YEAR THE TEAM PLACED 2ND. RACHEL ALSO HOLDS 4 TOURNAMENT TITLES AS A BRUIN AND WAS HONORED AS AN ALL-AMERICAN SCHOLAR ALL 4 YEARS WHILE EARNING HER DEGREE IN BIOLOGY.

A 2020 GRADUATE FROM EASTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY. MADALYN HOLDS THE SCHOOL RECORD FOR LOWEST 36 AND 54 HOLE SCORE. SHE ALSO WON 4 TOURNAMENT TITLES. WHILE SHE WAS AN EAGLE, SHE HAD 3 TOP 5 FINISHES AND 12 TOP 10 FINISHES. SHE CURRENTLY HOLDS 2 SCHOOL RECORDS: A SINGLE SEASON SCORING AVERAGE OF 72.46 IN 2019, AND AN OVERALL SCORING AVERAGE OF 75.06 . SHE ALSO SHOT HER CAREER BEST OF 69 TWICE DURING HER SENIOR YEAR AND HOLDS THE PROGRAM RECORD AT THE BATTLE AT OLD WORKS TOURNAMENT WITH A CAREER- BEST-TWO ROUND TOTAL OF 139.
