It's not just Handicaps and Championships...here's how the OGA contributes to the game:

## \$40,000



Passport proceeds paid to allied organizations over the past three years

## \$50,000



Reimbursed in the first three years to participating facilities through the Youth on Course Program which provides access to golf for kids at just \$5 per round

## \$10,000



Donated annually to the Oregon Turfgrass Foundation for research at Oregon State University, helping ensure superior turf conditions on Oregon golf courses

## \$40,000



Donated annually to the Evans Scholars Program which funds a student with a full-ride scholarship to the University of Oregon

## \$8,000



Provided in scholarships to kids who cannot afford to pay entry fees to play Oregon Junior Golf events (in 2016)

## \$23,000



Paid annually to member clubs through the OGA Online Membership Program

## \$472,000



Spent annually at host facilities, supporting the Oregon & SW Washington golf community
